

Dear Inter-Agency Games Colleagues,

URGENT: Flight Arrival and Departure times.

The <u>Empresa Plana</u> is the Official Transport Company for the 2015 UN Inter-Agency Games. The bus company will provide round trip transportation for participants between the Barcelona (El Prat) or Reus airports and the Port Aventura hotels on 29 April and 3 May. <u>In order to ensure that we have the correct number of buses on those dates please ensure that the flight schedules of times and arrivals are up to date. In the registration database we are still missing more than 700 arrival and departure times. It is imperative that we have the schedule of arrivals for those participants who arrive on 29 April and/or depart on 3 May. This information is very important to the Company which is providing the transportation so that it can schedule the buses accordingly. If there are 500 people who show up unexpectedly, there will be longer waiting times. We will give priority to the participants who have informed of their times of arrival.</u>

WHO ARE THE IAG Participants?

We are more than 1500 participants coming from 51 UN agencies. There are 125 different nationalities represented.

The UN staff who participate in the UN Inter-Agency Games are very accomplished in their professions and are also very accomplished in their sport disciplines. We have had Davis Cup players, ATP ranked tennis players, a Chinese Olympic volleyball team player, world champion table tennis player, an Olympic silver medalist (participating this year), members of Swiss national Championship tennis team, Swiss International bridge team member (world class ranking) all participating in the Games. And these are only the ones that I know personally. The majority of these players participate in National and regional competitions in their home countries. This is who we are.

Why do we do this?

We must all remember the reason that we organize and participate in the Games. It is fine to win trophies and medals. However, we must never loose sight of the aims of the Inter-Agency Games. Rule number 1 of the General Rules of the IAG:

"The purpose of the United Nations Inter-Agency Games (IAG) shall be to enable current and retired members of the agencies and organizations of the

<u>United Nations system and other eligible organizations to get to know each other through sports and other recreational activities and thereby to improve mutual understanding and work relations."</u>
